Project Spotlight

This month, we're excited to spotlight a new feature in Microsoft Planner Premium Plans: Baseline. If you've ever wondered whether your project is on track or needs adjustments, this feature is for you.

Baseline is your project's snapshot in time, capturing the state of your project plan at a specific moment. This gives you a solid reference point to compare against your current progress. Think of it as your project's 'before' picture – perfect for seeing how far you've come or what changes are needed.

Getting started with Baseline is simple. Navigate to the Baseline button and select "Create baseline." That's it! Your project's Baseline is now recorded. As your project evolves, you can revisit this Baseline to check if everything is moving according to plan or make some tweaks where necessary.

FAQs:

Can I import Baselines from Project Desktop or other tools? Not yet!

Can I create multiple Baselines?
Currently, you can only capture one at a time.

Are only project-level details being captured?

No, the Baseline records specific details for each task, including start and finish dates, percent completion, duration, and work.
