The milestones

October 2025 - End of sales

After this date, Microsoft will stop selling Project Online licences to new customers.

<u>Customers:</u> If you're already using Project Online, nothing changes immediately. But you won't be able to add new standalone Project Online subscriptions. Any expansion of your environment will need to be planned differently.

April 2026 - Workflow support ends

Project Online relies heavily on legacy SharePoint 2013 workflows. From April 2026, Microsoft will stop supporting those workflows.

We are excited to spotlight a project that we have recently completed for the Department of State Development, Infrastructure, and Planning (DSDIP).


DSDIP facilitates the capital planning and reporting for agencies across Queensland. Senior stakeholders required a Capital Program Pipeline Scenario Tool to enable decision-makers to model and compare multiple funding scenarios for future capital investments.

The tool we designed and built in collaboration with key users provides dynamic, real-time functionality, enabling teams to collaborate on and compare multiple funding scenarios. It offers live visibility of allocated spend by sector, agency, and region, allowing users to identify where budgets may exceed their guardrails across a 10-year outlook.

This tool will be rolled out shortly for operational use in the next planning period. We are confident that the up-to-date user interface will create a positive user experience for stakeholders who are trying to gain a better understanding of what the future could look like.

We anticipate that as people use the tool more frequently, we will receive feedback on how to improve its functionality and expand its scope. This is what we thrive on partnering with our customers to continuously improve.




